Global Citizenship Program:

Degree requirements – 6 *credit hours as indicated below:*

FRSH 1200 First Year Seminar 3 credit hours or designated substitute for transfer students

Global Citizenship Program Keystone Seminar 3 credit hours

General Course Requirements: 24 credit hours of knowledge/skills courses. *Each GCP course is coded for a knowledge area and a skill*. You need:

Knowledge Areas (24 total credits): Roots of Cultures (6 hours—two different prefixes); Social Systems and Human Behavior (6 hours—two different prefixes); Physical and Natural World (3 hours); Global Understanding (3 hours); Arts Appreciation (3 hours); Quantitative Literacy (3 hours).

Skills Requirements: All students must complete three credit hours in courses coded for each of the following skills: Written Communication; Oral Communication; Critical Thinking; Intercultural Competence; and Ethical Reasoning.

Students will usually complete the Skills Requirement with courses in the GCP Course Requirements but may also complete it with appropriately coded courses within their major, or within other coded courses not part of the GCP.

Residency Requirement

Students are required to complete 30 of their last 36 credit hours directly from Webster University. Departmental residency requirements for the particular major must also be met.

Probationary Readmission

Students who left the University on academic probation and who are accepted for readmission will be readmitted on academic probation. Failure to earn a 2.0 GPA in the returning semester will result in dismissal.

Students who were academically dismissed from the University must have completed at least 12 transferable credit hours from another college or university and must have been away from Webster University for at least one year. Dismissed students, if accepted for readmission, may be readmitted on academic probation. Dismissed students who are readmitted on academic probation and who fail to earn a 2.0 GPA in their first semester upon return to the University are dismissed with no opportunity for appeal.

Business Office Holds

Students who have holds on their accounts from the Business Office will not be accepted for readmission or be able to register until all financial problems have been resolved. Students with pre-payment holds will be required to pay their full tuition at the time of registration.

Disciplinary Sanctions Holds

Students who have holds on their registration due to disciplinary sanctions must complete those sanctions and have the hold removed by the Associate Dean of Student Affairs before they will be considered for readmission or allowed to register.
