

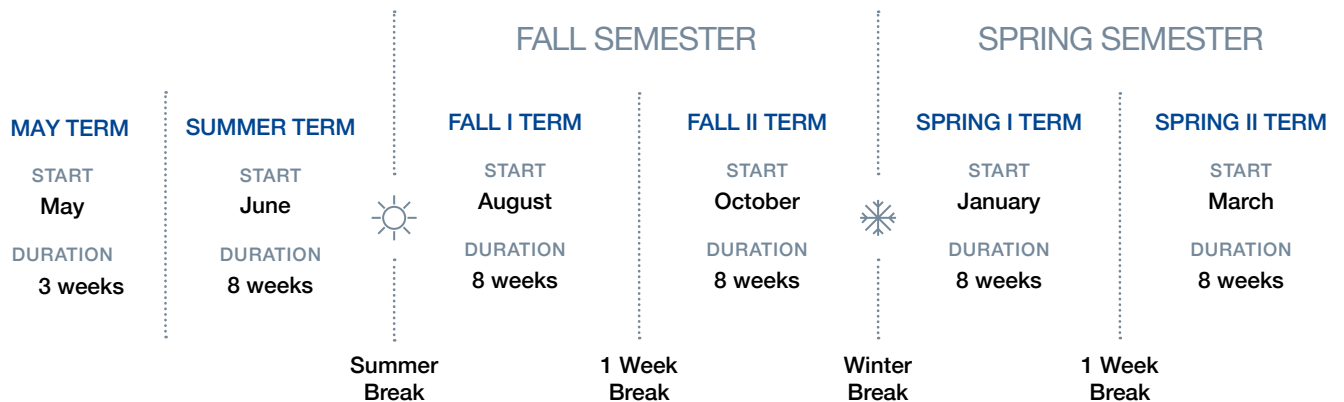

When should I apply?

Webster Vienna has rolling admissions, which means that you can apply anytime.

Additionally, you do not need to wait until you have received your high school diploma. Your application will be evaluated once you have submitted it.

If you require a visa, we strongly recommend that you apply a minimum of 6 months before the term start date. The visa process might take 3 to 9 months depending on your country of citizenship. You should apply for your visa as soon as you have been accepted to Webster University and have received your acceptance package, which includes a visa application form. In case your visa is not ready, please notify your Admissions Officer so he/she can defer your acceptance to the next starting term.

The average Undergraduate degree takes 4 years to complete.

However students can be awarded advanced standing credit towards their bachelor's degree. Credit awards are based upon the marks/grades you have obtained and the specific programs you have completed.

STEP 1 - Submit Online Application

Visit our online application page: webster.ac.at/apply-now
Fill out all the required fields and click "Submit Application".

Once you have done so, you will be able to log back in at any time and upload the Application Documents (listed below).

STEP 2 - Upload Undergraduate Application Documents

1 Passport

A copy of the biographical page of your passport.

2 Motivational Essay

A 300 to 500-word essay on a topic of your choice. The essay should be a new, original work, written by you specifically for this application.

3 Letter of Recommendation

Your recommender can either fill out the Webster recommendation forms which can be found online or he/she can write a recommendation letter, however this must be printed on official school/company paper. This form should be submitted by a teacher, professor, or counselor familiar with your academic performance.

4 University Transcripts

Should you have already attended a University, you will need to submit all transcripts including results.

5 High School Transcripts

Official transcripts showing secondary school coursework and results of the past 3 years.

In case you have not yet graduated from high school, you may submit your current transcripts (example, American school system grade 9 to 11), including results.

International Baccalaureate (IB):
Students taking the IB diploma, should submit their predicted grades, or their IB diploma including results.

GCE (A level) / GCSE (O level):
Students taking A or O levels should upload all awarded certificates.

If your transcripts are not in English, you will need to have them translated. We require the official/original translated document (this document must include a photocopy of the transcript in its original language, attached to it). English translator MUST be certified, in order to legally guarantee the quality of the English translation.

6 English Proficiency Exam

If you are not a native English speaker, you are required to submit proof of your English skills.

→ **TOEFL iBT:** Min. overall score of 80

→ **IELTS Academic:** Min. overall score of 6.0

→ **Cambridge Advanced Certificate (CAE only):** Score A, B, C

→ **IB Diploma:** HL English A – min. score 4
HL English B – min. score 5
SL English A – min. score 5
SL English B – min. score 6

English is waived for citizens of, or someone who completed their studies in the following countries: USA, Canada (except Quebec), UK, Ireland, Australia, New Zealand.



Undergraduate Financial Information

Tuition Cost

Most course fees are for 3 credit hour courses including text books.

One academic year consists of 5 terms (Summer 2019 - Spring II 2020)

ANNUAL FEE	€ 20,600
SEMESTER FEE FULL TIME 12–18 credits (equals 4–6 courses) per semester	€ 10,300
PART TIME up to 11 credits	€ 645 per 1 credit hour
SUMMER TERM (OPTIONAL)	€ 645 per 1 credit hour

- **Sponsorship**
Organizations or individuals may sponsor a student's education.

- **Private Student Loan Programs**
Student loan programs from a private lender in Austria, or from a bank or private lender in one's country of origin.

- **US Financial Aid**
American citizens and green card holders may be eligible to apply for financial assistance from the US Government (Student loans, Pell Grants, etc.).

- **VA and GI Bill**
Webster University programs are approved for veterans' educational benefits.

- **Austrian Federal Financial Aid**
Austrian citizens and non-Austrian students whose parents have been employed in Austria for a minimum of five years may be eligible for assistance from the Austrian government.

→ First time Freshmen only	5–10% tuition reduction
→ Proof of core or extended family attending/graduated from WVPU

→ GPA of 3.9–4.0	Full tuition (renewable annually)
→ Additional excellence criteria will be considered.
