

Topics for Student Essays Upon Application to Webster Vienna

You are asked to write a brief essay, preferably about 400 words (in software "Word", font Times New Roman, size 12, spell-checked), on one of the topics listed below.

Your essay has to be your own work, done without anybody's help and without any external resources.

TOPIC I

"Write about your role model or a person you aspire to be like, and explain how you think Webster University could help you follow in his or her footsteps."

TOPIC II

"In order to be successful in tomorrow's world, one will have to understand the complexities of the global economy. Discuss with concrete details how you can start gaining such understanding."

TOPIC III

"Describe the neighborhood in which you grew up and how it influenced your development making you into the person you are today."

TOPIC IV

"Imagine you are invited to have dinner with Bill Gates or with Mark Zuckerberg (your choice). Describe what you would like to discuss with either one and how you would make them get interested in you."

TOPIC V

"Write about your favorite childhood reading and explain why you still remember this particular story (or book) so fondly."
