

## Graduate Research Summit (GRS) Call for Abstracts & Abstract Guidelines

The Graduate Research Summit 2020 calls for abstracts (no longer than 500 words, PDF format) from the following fields of study:

Business and Management  
Finance  
International Relations  
Marketing  
Psychology

This call is for abstracts of graduate research of Webster Vienna Private University. Abstracts will be considered for one or both of the following: oral presentations and poster presentations. All oral presentation abstracts received will be considered for poster presentations, but poster presentation abstracts will not be considered for oral presentations. Please identify whether your abstract is for an oral presentation or poster presentation.

All abstracts must be submitted through the Google Form at the following address:

Submissions for an oral presentation should be from completed or nearly completed thesis proposal or research. Projects do not necessarily need to present findings, but must provide a thorough literature review, justification of the research project, and methodology. Please keep in mind that you will have a 15 minute maximum for presentations and will have a 5 minute Q&A session afterwards.

Submissions for a poster presentation should be from one of the following: a thesis proposal, a mini-thesis, a capstone, a completed thesis or a nearly completed thesis.

Graduate students and alumni of Webster Vienna Private University or Webster University are strongly encouraged to submit abstracts. Graduate students and alumni of Webster Worldwide campuses are also encouraged to submit abstracts, however, there is no financial assistance available for travel or any other expenses to be incurred by attending the Graduate Research Summit.

The deadline for submitting an abstract is **March 27, 2020 at 11:59pm**. Those awarded a spot as either oral or poster presenters will be notified by the email provided after the Scientific Committee reviews all submissions.

Submissions of those without any formal affiliation with Webster (either through alumni status or current student status) will not be considered, but all are welcome to RSVP to the event at [grs@webster.ac.at](mailto:grs@webster.ac.at). The Graduate Research Summit will take place at Palais Wenkheim (Praterstrasse 23, 1020 Vienna) on April 24, 2020 from 4:00 pm until 7:00pm.
