Prerequisite

Program Prerequisites

Program prerequisites are to be completed before beginning coursework for the MSc in Finance for those students who have not completed prerequisite courses (or an appropriate equivalent) within five years of entering the program with a grade of B or better. If the appropriate prerequisite course content was completed more than five years prior to entering the program, the department will allow a waiver if the student demonstrates their command of the content area by successfully completing a waiver examination. If you are interested in taking a prerequisite waiver examination, please see your advisor.

Notes

- Asterisks denote that a course has prerequisites. Students must observe prerequisite requirements. If you follow the sequence above, you will meet all prerequisites.
- All courses are worth 3 US credits unless otherwise noted.
