

Smoking policy

Main campus

It is the continued goal of Webster University to protect the public health and environment of its members by promoting an environment free of second hand smoke.

While Webster University respects the rights of individuals to use tobacco and nicotine, it has been determined that smoking is detrimental to the health of users and of others within close proximity. Therefore, in congruence with official Student Handbook policies all campus buildings are designated as smoke free areas. Smoking is permitted outside of and from a minimum distance of 30 feet (10 meters) away from entrances to University buildings.

Violation of the student code of conduct will be handled according to existing University policies and procedures governing the conduct of students, staff, and faculty.

Smoking is not permitted in resident rooms, balconies or common areas in the halls and apartments. Receptacles for disposal of cigarette butts are provided outside the residence hall on Heinestrasse side only. Students are responsible for the proper disposal of cigarette butts. Failure to do so could result in monetary fines imposed on all students living in units where cigarette butts are found in the vicinity. Possession of hookahs, cigars, and pipes is prohibited. Students found smoking in prohibited locations can be fined up to EUR 100, as well as be financially responsible for any damage done to the facilities (i.e. smoking in a residential room may require that the entire space needs to be cleaned and painted).
