

Dear Students,

We have received a number of inquiries from you with regards to the Fall II and spring courses. The following is a simple update. Please read carefully.

- Our goal is to offer the majority of our courses in person on campus by our faculty (hybrid classes). Students who are not able to attend can either follow the live feed or (if you are e.g. in a different time zone) the recorded sessions.
 - You may choose whether you attend on-site or not, but we ask you to inform your instructors.
 - If you will be attending all of your courses remotely, please send an e-mail to the Academic Services Office (Petra.Bocus-Thurn@webster.ac.at) with your name and Student ID.
 - Classes taught by faculty belonging to a known risk group will be offered remotely.
 - If a course consistently has fewer than five students present with all the others attending online, the course may be shifted entirely online at any point.
 - Classes, which are being taught remotely, will have the word “REMOTE” written into the title of the class on [Courses@WVPU](#).
- Books: If you are in the country and able to come to campus, books will be available via the Textbook Service. If you have to join remotely, you should plan to order your books from your preferred suppliers. The university will reimburse you. Please check our [COVID-19 FAQ page](#) for more details and instructions for reimbursement.

Together with the COVID-19 Task Force we continue to closely monitor the recent developments of the pandemic in Vienna. In the event that universities move from Yellow to Orange in Austria’s official [Covid-19 Traffic Light system](#), WVPU will be expected to enact further health measures.
