1) Campus closure

Webster University classes at almost all locations have moved to an online environment for the remainder of the spring 2020 semester in response to global COVID-19 public health efforts, in accordance with local conditions and public directives. This means, that also all Vienna classes will only be taught online for the remainder of Spring II. Campus closure will continue until we receive further notice from the Austrian ministry and authorities.
