 - o prerequisites: no (!) prior knowledge of German or consent of Language Center Coordinator
- **GRMN 1100** Elementary German II (A1.2)
 - o prerequisites: GRMN 1090 or consent of Language Center Coordinator
- **GRMN 2090** Intermediate German I (A2.1)
 - o prerequisites: GRMN 1100 or consent of Language Center Coordinator
- **GRMN 2100** Intermediate German II (A2.2)
 - o prerequisites: GRMN 2090 or consent of Language Center Coordinator
- **GRMN 3090** Advanced German I (B1.1)
 - o prerequisites: GRMN 2100 or consent of Language Center Coordinator
- **GRMN 3100** Advanced German II (B1.2)
 - o prerequisites: GRMN 3090 or consent of Language Center Coordinator
- **GRMN 3150** Culture and Civilization of German Speaking Countries (B1+)
 - o prerequisites: GRMN 3090 or consent of Language Center Coordinator
- **GRMN 4170** Advanced Conversational German I (B2.1)
 - o prerequisites: GRMN 3150 or consent of Language Center Coordinator
